V.I. Division of Personnel Announces Upcoming Correction Officer Exam

Are you or someone you know interested in a career in the Corrections field?

The V.I. Bureau of Corrections is accepting registrations for its upcoming Correction Officer Exam. The exam is slated for November 29-December 3, 2021 and those interested in registering for the written test must submit a complete application package online at www.dopusvi.org by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, November 5, 2021.

"We are seeking qualified, motivated men and women interested in careers in Corrections to join our dedicated team," V.I. Bureau of Corrections Director Wynnie Testamark said. "If you're interested in a career in public service and in helping others, this is a great opportunity."

Applicants must be 20 years of age, but not older than 46, and a United States citizen. They must also have a high school diploma or equivalent certification from an accredited institution, and a Motor Vehicle Operator's License. Further, candidates must successfully pass a Civil Service online examination, physical agility test, psychological exam, oral board interview, and comprehensive background check.

The following candidates are exempt from sitting the written examination, but are required to meet all other established criteria:

- Persons holding a degree in any field of study (Associates and above) from an accredited institution;
- All honorably discharged veterans from any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces (DD214); or,
- Certified Correction Officers from any U.S. jurisdiction correctional facility in good standing.
